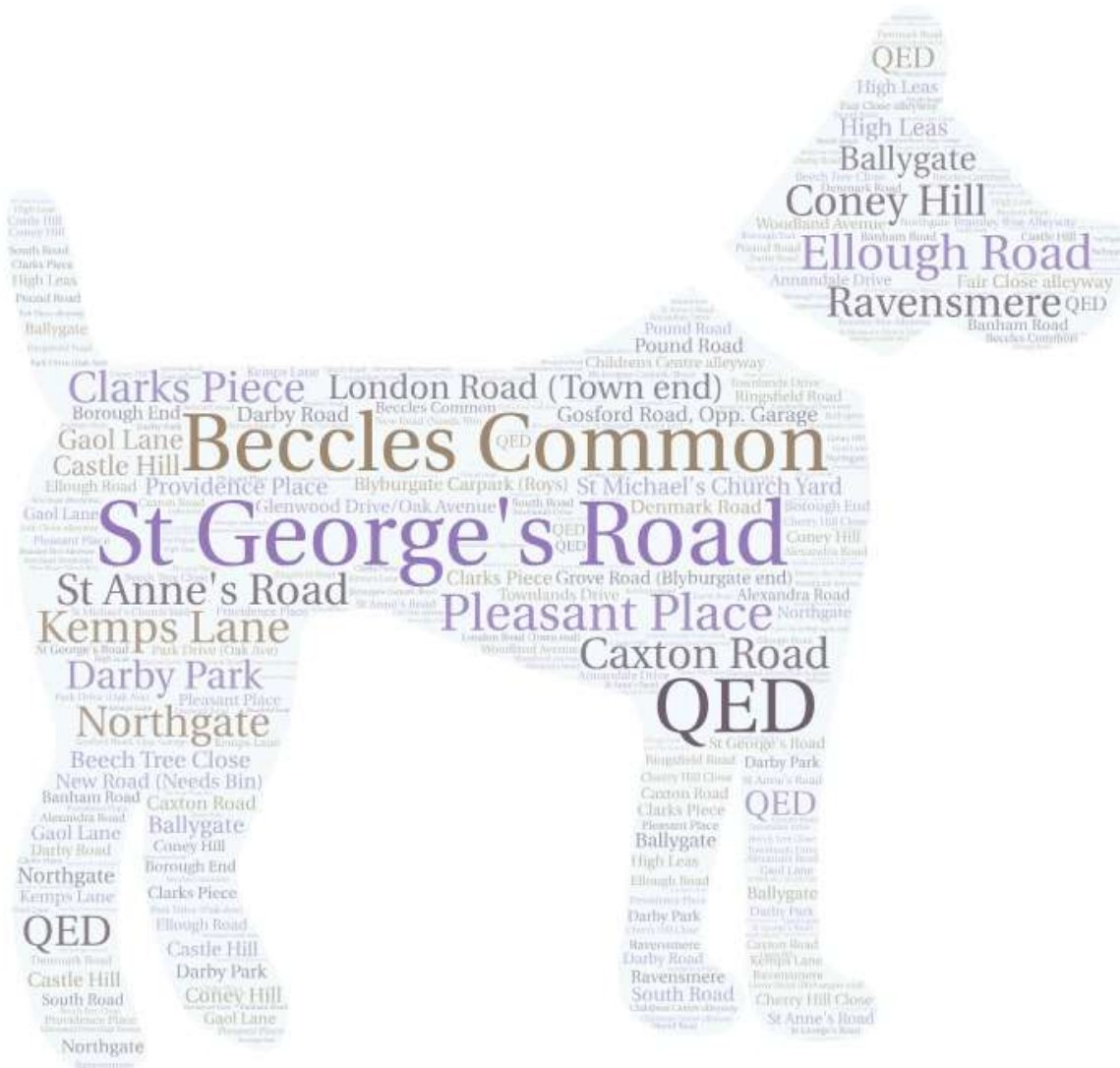


Beccles Dog Fouling Analysis



Over three weeks data has been gathered on social media to give a snapshot of the frequency of dog fouling on different roads in Beccles.

These conclusions can be drawn from this data:

- St Georges road has twice as many reports of dog fouling than any other road in Beccles.
- Many people responding to the survey complained of a 'route' that was particularly problematic which included Pleasant Place, St Georges road and London Road. There are no bins on Pleasant Place or St Georges road.
- It would definitely be worth focusing in on the St Georges road area for solutions.
- Beccles Common also scored highly, with people mentioning that dogs were 'let out' whilst people sat in their cars in the car park. There are bins on Beccles Common.
- The problem is fairly wide spread, with lots of roads mentioned several times. With Elough road, Caxton Road and St Annes Road also scoring highly.
