### **General Discussion of Draft 3**

What can we do in this four week delay? Worlingham NP team want to get together informally with us. Perhaps at our February meeting.

The new Waveney Local Plan is expected to be adopted by WDC Full Council in March. It will then carry full weight in determining planning applications. If Larkfleet submit an application for their section of the Garden Neighbourhood it will be judged against this new Local Plan which clearly states a master-plan approach for the entire site would be necessary.
